RULES & REGULATIONS GOVERNING THE MOVEMENT OF BUILDINGS & SPECIAL LOADS

1. Route to be checked by applicant for obstructions prior to movement. All utilities to be relocated prior to movement at applicant's expense. Continuous movement of vehicle with load required. The granting of a permit shall not be considered as a guarantee of the sufficiency of a highway; highway width or vertical clearance; or highway structure for transporting on the route. If a highway sign, structure, signal or railing is to be moved, the applicant shall secure Road Commission approval prior to the move and shall be responsible for all costs.
2. Movement to be made during periods of reduced traffic. Vehicles traveling under this permit shall maintain a distance of not less than 2,000 feet apart.
3. To be towed by at least a 1 1/2 ton truck with dual wheels. Applicant shall insure vehicle has adequate HP and braking to pull the load. Auxiliary power unit required on move.
4. The movement of a Building or Special Load requires the display of 6 clean, plain red or orange flags at least 18 inches square. One flag shall be displayed on each end of the front bumper of the towing vehicle and shall be supported on a short staff at an angle so as to wave freely. One flag shall be displayed on each corner of the Building or Special Load and placed so as to be clearly seen by approaching traffic. At least 2 flashing or rotating amber lights to be placed on the extreme rear of the load. All flashing or rotating amber lights to be visible for a distance of 500 feet.
5. To be equipped with 2 OVERSIZE LOAD signs of black, block lettering on Interstate yellow Background. One 6'x16" sign with 12" lettering on front bumper of towing vehicle. One 8'x18" sign with 16" lettering on rear of load, bottom of sign not less than 7' above highway. Towing vehicle headlights to be turned on low beam.
6. To be preceded by one escort vehicle (passenger car or pickup truck) with at least one flashing or rotating amber light on the roof of the escort vehicle. In addition, there will be displayed on the roof of the escort vehicle, one OVERSIZE LOAD sign 5' long by 12" high with 8" high black letters on yellow background. If height of the vehicle or load exceeds 14' 6", the escort vehicle will be required to have a fixed measuring device set at a height to assure clearance of the load. All flashing or rotating amber lights to be visible for a distance of 500 feet.
7. Police supervision of traffic required on move. (Confirmation supplied to Road Commission prior to move) Permit not valid for movement when wind velocity exceeds 25 MPH. Permit valid only if favorable driving and traffic conditions prevail. Movement must minimize the obstruction of normal flow of traffic. Continuous two-way communication is required between escort vehicles and the towing vehicle. The transporting of a Building or Special Load is allowed only when the surface condition of the highway is not slippery. Valid during daylight hours only beginning one half hour before sunrise and ending one half hour after sunset.
8. Permits are automatically invalidated by the violation of any of the conditions specified by the terms of the permit or by false information given on the application. Failure to comply with the conditions of this permit shall be just cause for the immediate suspension or revocation of any or all permits and the operator and/or owner of the vehicle subject to appropriate legal action. Any of the following actions shall immediately void the permit and subject the applicant to appropriate legal action: (a) Misrepresentation of information set forth in an application for permit; (b) Any operation on highways beyond the size or weight limitations shown on the permit; (c) A change or erasure on a permit. The Road Commission may temporarily suspend or revoke a Building or Special Load Permit, either in its entirety or in respect to certain of its provisions, due to seasonal conditions, other special conditions or if it is in the interest of the public's safety.
9. A vehicle shall not be loaded or unloaded within the highway right-of-way unless permitted by a police officer or agent of the road commission.
10. The permit shall be carried in the vehicle to which it applies and must be available for inspection.
11. A load shall be arranged to effect the minimum dimensions for height, length or width. All hydraulic attachments or mechanisms must be securely immobilized with adequate chains and binders. Vehicles must have air or lift axles on ground.
12. Applicant agrees to accept responsibility for any damage caused to wires, mailboxes, trees, buildings, or the road, including the structures and appurtenances, and shall reimburse the appropriate parties for any damage caused by the moving of said vehicle or load. Applicant shall save harmless, indemnify, defend, and represent the Board against any and all claims for bodily injury or property damage, or any other claim arising out of or related to the moving of said vehicle, load, or its presence on or use of the highway by said vehicle and load.
13. Permits are not valid if insurance expires. Applicant to present evidence that at least the following insurance coverage is in full force and effect on each vehicle while operating on the public highways under special permit:

Automobile Bodily Injury liability – each person	\$ 500,000.00
Automobile Bodily Injury liability – each accident	\$ 1,000,000.00
Automobile Property Damage liability – each accident	\$ 1,000,000.00
Automobile Single Limit policy	\$ 1,000,000.00
General Liability – per occurrence/aggregate.....	\$ 1,000,000.00
14. In the event of a breakdown or unavoidable delay, an attempt shall be made to remove the building from the highway. If the building cannot be removed it shall be clearly marked with warning lights, the Road Commission shall be contacted and assistance given with directing traffic.
15. A building may be moved between the side rails of bridges if the horizontal clearance between such rails exceeds the width of the building by at least 12 inches. If the width of the building is greater than the horizontal clearance of any bridge, the building must be loaded on the moving equipment in such manner that the under side of supporting cross members will clear the rails by at least 12 inches at all times.
